The Report on the implementation path of the Program illustrates in detail the procedural and financial progress of the PSR of the Sardinia Region 2014/2020 starting from its approval until December 2018.

The purpose of the Report is to reconstruct the path and development of the implementation of the RDP in its first three years of implementation, through the different procedural steps, the progression of operations and payments.

The overall time frame of the procedures started and the relative timescales is shown in Fig. 1: each single bar indicates the duration of a procedure, starting from the date of publication of the call until the final deadline for submitting applications.

The earliest procedures launched in 2015 were those relating to the implementation of the LEADER approach, then there were the 2016 calls for measures based on surfaces or animals. The first procedures for structural measures date back to summer 2016.

In terms of application forms, the measures with the best results were 4.1 and 6.1 as regards structural measures (Fig. 2), and 13 and 14 for area or animal based measures (Fig. 3).

The latter were also those that produced the vast majority of applications funded to date, while the share of applications under evaluation is still largely prevalent among structural measures, also with reference to procedures launched in 2016.

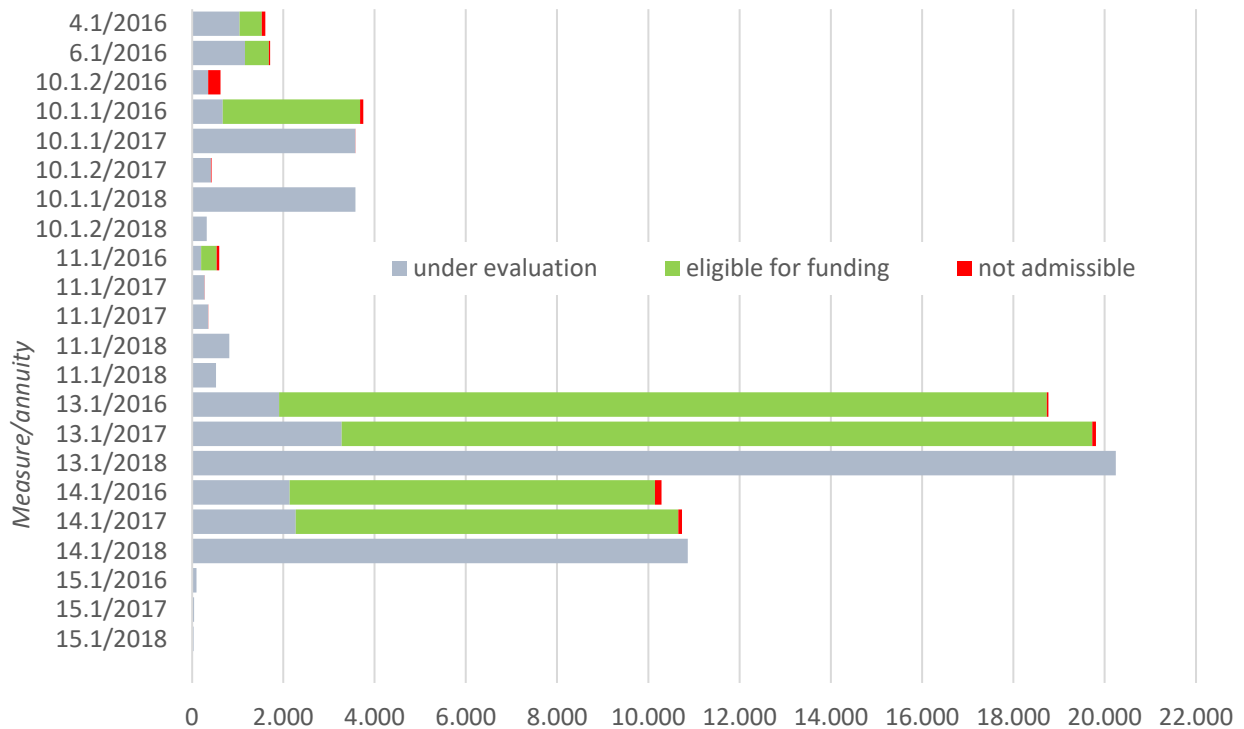


Fig. 4. Commitments and payments made by measure and annuity

Given the large number of applications still under evaluation and procedures awaiting results, commitments and payments are essentially concentrated on five or six measures: the 13, the 14, the 10 among the area or animal based measures, and 4.1, 6.1 and 4.2 among the structural ones (Fig. 4).
